

# Privacy policy

## General

1. This Privacy Policy explains the manner of collection and processing by Detalion Games SA (hereinafter “Detalion Games”) of the user’s personal data.
2. Administrator of personal data is: Detalion Games SA (**henceforward referred to as “Administrator”**).
3. Personal data are processed accordingly to European Parliament and Council Regulation (UE) 2016/679 from April 27th, 2016 r. on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of the directive 95/46/WE (henceforward referred to as: GDPR) and other applicable regulations and laws.
4. Personal data can be processed by the Administrator with the purpose of:
  1. Sharing your personal data with Google Inc for email service and storing the participants’ list in the services provided by Google Inc.
  2. Sharing your personal data with The Rocket Science Group LLC (henceforward referred to as: The Newsletter Provider) for sending the newsletter.
5. Personal data are processed by the Administrator only for the time necessary to achieve the purposes of their processing indicated in this Privacy Policy or the Administrator fulfills the obligations imposed by law, and if the period of limitation of claims resulting from these goals is longer – until the expiry of the limitation period.
6. Recipients of personal data may be entities cooperating with the Administrator in the provision of electronic services and the conclusion and performance of providing technical notices, updates, alerts, and support and administrative notifications, participating in handling complaints; entities that provide the Administrator with advisory, marketing, service and IT services providers. That can be:
  1. Google Inc.
  2. The Rocket Science Group LLC
7. Under the rules defined in the provisions regulating the protection of personal data, the Customer has the right to request access to data, rectify them, limit their processing, deletion, the right to transfer data, and the right to file a complaint to the President of the Office of Personal Data Protection
8. In cases where the processing is based on the legitimate interest of the Administrator (Article 6 par. 1. letter f), the Customer has the right to object to the processing of personal data, if it is justified by a special situation of the Customer or if personal data is processed for direct marketing
9. In addition, in cases where personal data is processed on the basis of the consent expressed by the Customer, the Customer is entitled to withdraw the consent at any time, without affecting the legality of the processing, which was made on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
10. The above-mentioned rights (apart from the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory body) may be carried out by the Customer by sending a relevant request to the following address: [info@detaliongames.com](mailto:info@detaliongames.com)
11. The Administrator declares that persons employed in the processing of personal data have been given the authorization to process personal data and that they have been familiar with the regulations on the protection of personal data and the responsibility for their non-compliance, they have committed to comply with them and for indefinite secrecy of processed data personal data and ways to secure them.

## Complaints

1. When submitting a complaint, the Customer provides the data necessary to handle this complaint by the Administrator.
2. Data provided by the Customer when submitting a complaint is processed by the Administrator on the basis of art. 6 par. 1 let. b GDPR, in order to handle this complaint.
3. Providing personal data indicated in the complaint form is necessary to consider the complaint by the Administrator.

## Cookie Policy

The website does not automatically collect any information, except for the information contained in cookie files.

Cookies are IT data, in particular, text files, which are stored on the Website User's end device and are intended for using the Website's services. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, their storage time on the end device, and a unique number.

The entity that places cookies on the User's terminal device and obtains access to them is Detalion Games SA.

Cookies are used to:

- adjusting the content of the Website pages to the User's preferences and optimizing the use of websites; in particular, these files allow recognizing the User's device and properly display the website, adapted to the characteristics of the device
- creating statistics that help to understand how Users use websites, which allows improving their structure and content
- providing Users with advertising content tailored to their interests, including remarketing
- maintaining the User's session, thanks to which the User does not have to re-enter their login and password on every subpage of the Website

The Website uses two basic types of cookies: "session" and "persistent" cookies. Session cookies are temporary files that are stored on the User's end device until logging out, leaving the website or turning off the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored in the User's device for the time specified in the cookie file parameters or until they are deleted by the User.

The Website uses the following types of cookies:

- "Necessary" cookies, enabling the use of services available on the Website, e.g. authentication cookies used for services that require authentication on the Website
- cookies used to ensure security e.g. used to detect fraud in the field of authentication on the Website
- "Performance" cookies, enabling the collection of information on the use of Website pages

- "Functional" cookies that enable "remembering" the settings selected by the User and personalization of the User's interface, e.g. in the scope of the selected language or region of the User's origin, font size, website appearance, etc.
- "Advertising" cookies, enabling users to provide advertising content more tailored to their interests

In many cases, software used for browsing websites (web browser) allows cookies to be stored in the User's device by default. Users can change their cookie settings at any time. These settings can be changed in particular in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the settings of the web browser or inform about their every posting on the User's device. Detailed information about the possibilities and ways of handling cookies are available in the software settings (web browser) and in the help files available in the browser menu. Failure to change the cookie settings means that they will be placed on the end device of the User, and thus we will store information on the User's device and access this information.
